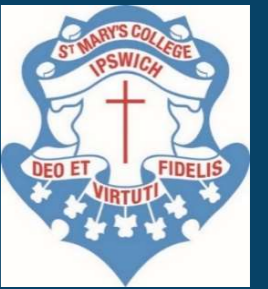

Goal 1: Community

We work in solidarity with our community, seeking to maintain strong collaborative connections to strengthen communication, learning environments and professional processes.

To achieve this goal, we will:

1. Enact the College Master Plan
2. Update our community regularly to spotlight student engagement in learning and community activities
3. Gather community voice through parent, student and staff forums

Goal 2: Learning

2. Implementation of revised NCCD processes to strengthen strategies that reflect best practice in supporting differentiation for student needs.
3. Revise the College timetable to ensure that time allocations and structures reflect Australian Curriculum, Senior Curriculum and student needs.

Our success in 2025 will be measured by:

- Engagement of data informed and research based practices, processes and pedagogies that ensure enhanced learning outcomes for students.
- Delivery of a revised timetable structure that best meets the needs of the St Mary's College community in 2026.
